SOUTH DAKOTA PEACE OFFICERS' ASSOCIATION AUXILIARY \$200 ANNUAL SCHOLARSHIP

A \$200 scholarship will be chosen by lottery at the South Dakota Peace Officers' Association seminar each year in September. At the time of the drawing, the financial register will be reviewed, and a vote will be taken at that time, to increase the number of scholarships to be awarded. A minimum of one scholarship will be awarded each year. The first name drawn will receive \$200 to be used as needed. An alternate name will also be picked at that time in case the applicant does not meet the eligibility requirements. The same procedure will follow for each scholarship should more be approved by the members at the time of the seminar. Verification of school registration will be done as soon as possible after the completion of the first semester or quarter, and then a check will be sent to the student(s).

1. The application must be by an auxiliary member; or the child, grandchild or great-grandchild of an auxiliary member of the South Dakota Peace Officers' Association.
2. The applicant must be attending any of the following: community college; junior college; university; trade school; or technical school.
3. Applicants may send an application each year they are continuing their education.
4. Applicants must attach a single sheet of paper to the application and write a short piece indicating what their future goals are and how their continuing education will assist them in reaching their goals.
5. All applications must be postmarked by September 1 to be eligible for the drawing in September. Only one application per student per year.

Until recently, there was no reliable way of predicting how an situation was going to end - with or without violence. During this session a new prediction model will be shown that is statistically sound and tested. This context model will provide negotiators, SWAT officers and On-Scene Commanders with an easily understood and applied model for outcome prediction.
